#### <u>Availity expanded India GCC with new facility in</u> Bengaluru

Availity has expanded its India GCC with a new facility in Bengaluru, supported by a USD 4.3 Mn investment, transforming the centre from a product support hub into a full-scale innovation and technology hub. The company aims to triple its India headcount from 250 to 800+ by 2026, focusing on talent in product engineering, cybersecurity, cloud, and data engineering.
